

The Charter Inspection and Evaluation Committee Govt. of Sindh which grades Private Sector Universities in Sindh issued its biannual report this year. According to the report CIEC has ranked Preston University Karachi 3rd out of 9 universities in the General Category and 9th out of total 24 Private Universities in the overall ranking in Sindh.

Major (R) Aftab Ahmed Lodhi, Director General Preston University, Karachi informed the audience about the formation of CIEC in 2002 by the then Governor of Sindh. He said that Guidelines to carry out inspection of Private Sector Universities were prepared by a Committee in which he was also a member in 2002. After approval of the Governor of Sindh these guidelines were issued to all the Private Sector Universities for implementation. As per the Guidelines, all Private Sector Universities are to be inspected biannually by CIEC which comprises of a Chairman and 6 Members, who are mostly sitting Vice Chancellors of Public Sector Universities, assisted by subject experts. After an in-depth inspection of all Educational Institutes the Committee grades them and prepares a report which is sent to the Chairman of provincial HEC. After provincial HEC's approval it is sent to the Chief Minister of Sindh, and later to the Governor of Sindh for his final approval.



Prof. Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan Rajput, Chairman CIEC in his address immensely appreciated the progress achieved by Preston University, Karachi during the last three years. He expressed the hope that Preston University would endeavor to attain greater progress in the years ahead.

At the end, to mark the outstanding achievement of the University a cake cutting ceremony was held, followed by a luncheon. Mementos were also presented to the Chief Guest and the Guest of Honor by Pro-Chancellor, Justice (R) Deedar Hussain Shah.





Vlartyrs of October 2005 Earthquake Remembered

To pay homage to the martyrs of October 8, 2005 devastating earthquake the faculty and staff of Preston University converged at the location where the ill-fated Margalla Towers collapsed and a large number of innocent souls lost their valuable lives. They offered fateha for the departed souls and laid floral wreath at the venue of the tragedy on behalf of the Chancellor of Preston University, Dr. Abdul Basit.

On October 8, 2016 the faculty and staff of Preston University assembled at the venue where the ill-fated Margalla Towers, Islamabad collapsed during the devastating earthquake of October 8, 2005. They paid homage to men, women and children who lost their valuable lives during the tragedy at the Margalla Towers Islamabad, and also for a large number of those who were killed by the calamitous earthquake at other places in the northern part of the country. Members of the management, faculty and staff of the University who gathered at the site of the tragedy offered fateha for the departed souls of those who died in the catastrophe. They also expressed their grief to the relatives of the victims of the disaster who were present at the venue. On this poignant occasion, a floral wreath was also laid at the location of the tragedy on behalf of Dr. Abdul Basit, Chancellor Preston University.

In his brief message Chancellor Preston University, Dr. Abdul Basit said that the tragedy of October 8, 2005 which took a heavy toll on thousands of innocent men, women and children who lost their valuable lives can never be forgotten by the nation. He further said that at that sad moment of utter anguish and grief the people of Pakistan immediately came forth and courageously faced up to the aftermath of the catastrophic earthquake. Their response to the catastrophe was unquestionably matchless. People from every nook and corner of the country stood firmly behind their earthquake-affected brethren, particularly thousands of those who lost their valuable lives in the calamity, and provided them every possible help. Dr. Basit said that the country takes genuine pride in its citizens who are always prepared to go out of the way to deal with such devastating happenings with immeasurable patience and fortitude.




inks MoU with KP Police School of Public Disorder and Riot Management



He said, by imparting state-of-the-art education and training to the youth of Pakistan Preston University has fulfilled a significant national obligation.













Under the MoUs inked between PINSAT-Preston University and the School of Science, Beijing Jiaotong University it has been mutually agreed that the two vital areas of mutual cooperation would be (1) Student and Faculty Exchange (2) Scientific and Educational Cooperation.

Under the students and faculty exchange program (1) BJTU will accept 3 PhD students annually from PINSAT with official recommendation if the students succeed in obtaining the scholarships from China Scholarship Council. According to the funding situation of the professors of BJTU, BJTU will endeavor, as much as possible, to accommodate more PINSAT students per year. Faculty exchange of PINSAT and BJTU will be arranged with mutual agreement of dates of visits. In addition, participation in a Nanotech workshop at BJTU by 10 students of PINSAT for one week will be arranged. Exchange students of either party are bound to the agreement inked for the Student Exchange Program. The duration of the exchange program for a student will be either for one academic year or one semester. Students participating in the exchange program will normally have completed at

least one year of their degree program at their home institution.

Under Scientific and Educational Cooperation, with the purpose of furthering scientific and educational cooperation. School of Science, Beijing Jiaotong University (BJTU), Beijing, China and Preston Institute of Nano Science and Technology (PINSAT), Preston University, Islamabad, Pakistan have mutually agreed to undertake activities that would be to their mutual benefits across the research and education areas they offer. The Scientific and Educational Cooperation memorandum records the understanding

of the parties in relation to the cooperative activities. Both institutions have consented to put in their best endeavors to further their mutual interests and, so far a they are able to do, make available to the cooperative activities their expertise, resources, and information.

In his brief remarks on the occasion, Prof. Feng Qibo, Dean of Science School of Science Beijing Jiaotong University (BJTU) at the outset gave a brief introduction of his institution.
